As you may be aware Callum Hunter, who is a student in Year 10 at Bexhill Academy, recently suffered a Spinal Stroke which has left him with life changing paralysis.

Callum enjoys Basketball and the Academy's Student Council have expressed a desire to contribute to the cost of purchasing a specialised wheelchair, which will allow him to continue to participate in the sport that he enjoys so much. The estimated cost of a chair is £3,000; if every student raises £3.00 this should be easily achieved, but there will, of course, be prizes for students who exceed our expectations!

Therefore, in order to support Callum and his family, we are holding a fundraising event at the Academy on Wednesday 19th July. On this day we will be encouraging every student to take part in a sponsored walk along a route within the school grounds. Students will be accompanied by the entire Staff of the Academy, who also wish to take part in this event.

Students who are unable to participate will be supervised within the Academy building and we appreciate that some students may be unable to take part for medical reasons.
