

FAQ's and Parent Survey Feedback

Do I need to print work for my child?

No, all work can be completed in the exercise book for each subject, on paper or typed. This should then be uploaded as a photo or a document to the relevant assignment on Google Classroom.

My child is spending less time on each lesson than they would if they were at school.

Students should aim to spend approximately one hour on each subject, each day. This may vary slightly for each individual but if significantly less than one hour is spent on a lesson, then the work completed is likely to not be detailed enough or to a high enough quality. There are also stretch tasks available within lessons for students to attempt.

My child is spending too much time on some lessons

Students should aim to spend approximately one hour on each subject, each day. This may vary slightly for each individual but if some Deep learning tasks/activities are taking too long, it is perfectly acceptable to complete and submit as much as you can within the time allocated. Upload this and message the subject teacher.

I do not know what my child's school timetable is.

All missed work will be logged on ClassCharts, please log into the app or website and look out for the 'Missed Remote Learning' points.
