Key Notices

Uniform

Just a reminder over the winter break to ensure that all uniform is ready for January. A reminder of our uniform expectations:

- A white shirt (Years 10 and 11) or a blue shirt (Years 7-9). No polo shirts until we move into our summer uniform.
- A tie (Year group specific colour)
- A Bexhill Academy school blazer. Students need to have their blazer with them every day. The blazer
 can be worn or carried around the academy (ideally worn), and worn for more formal events, such as
 assemblies.
- Black (plain), polishable shoes (no mesh trainers, no obvious branding).
- A choice of: navy trousers, navy (tailored) shorts, Bexhill Academy skirt with navy tights, culottes.

Also, a reminder that we accept one stud in each ear and no other jewellery. So, over the holidays, please do not allow your child to get any other piercings. Any other piercings that students have must be covered with either a plaster or a clear plastic retainer needs to be inserted. A reminder that we also do not permit fake nails, eyelashes or heavy makeup. A small amount of subtle make up is permitted. Please encourage your child to take off any other jewellery: such as bracelets, rings and necklaces.

Thank you for all of your support in ensuring that our students present well and are a credit to themselves, you and Bexhill Academy.

Mobile Phones

There is a very powerful 2-part series on channel 4 called 'Swiped: The school that banned smart phones'. Children at a school in Colchester gave up their phones completely (not just in school) for 21 days. Following the 21 days, there was a 17% drop in anxiety symptoms, an 18% reduction in symptoms related to depression, the children slept an average of one hour extra per night and there was a 3% improvement in working memory. I would encourage you to watch this and speak to your children about it. Perhaps even suggest a complete phone detox to your children!
