What we offer our Drama Scholars



Mathematics Scholarship



What we offer our Mathematics Scholars







As well as the general application process, applicants for the Academic Scholarships will be required to undertake a selection of technical assessments which include; science, mathematics, technical design reasoning and problem solving.



Application Process

The learners awarded with a Bexhill Academy Scholarship are those who demonstrate a plethora of qualities both in the academic and communal spheres. They will have an unrelenting drive towards scholarly success and demonstrate an impeccable attitude to learning, combined with mature interpersonal skills and the ability to integrate themselves into all aspects of the Academy's culture.

As such, prospective Scholars are required to sit a selection of assessments to evaluate their suitability, including tests of: creative writing, mathematics, reasoning and problem solving.

In return, successful applicants are given the opportunity of a world-class education and the widening of horizons on a global scale.

The application process begins in September with all students invited to apply for a Scholarship should they wish. The application process lasts until December with a series of interviews and assessments after which our new Scholars are inaugurated into the Scholarship Programme. A Scholarship will generally last for one year, from January through to December, but will include regular reviews. Scholars must continue to meet the awarding criteria of their Scholarship otherwise it could be revoked.

September

Application process opens and students are invited to complete an initial application form, personal statement and submit references.

October

Practical and written assessments take place.

November

Shortlisted candidates are invited for interview.

December

Successful Scholars join the programme and their exciting journey begins!
