UNIFORM POLICY

Members of the SLT along with members of our Pastoral teams will be on duty every morning to address uniform issues. Students will not be allowed in the building if they are not in correct uniform.

Where possible if students have incorrect uniform the Pastoral Manager team may contact home, and if appropriate students will be sent home to correct their uniform. Students can wear a coat or hoodie to school, but this must be taken off when entering the building.

Term 1-4 Uniform:

- **Shirts** must be button-down smart shirts (short or long sleeved) white for all year groups.
- **Ties** must be worn with the shirt. Ties must be the year group colour.
- **Blazers** are to be worn or carried but preferably worn.
- Trousers or shorts are permitted but must be tailored and smart and worn with ankle socks.
- Bexhill Academy skirts can be worn, but must be worn with black, non-patterned tights
- Shoes/trainers must have tags removed
- **Shoes/Trainers** must be **all black and polishable.** Shoes/Trainers with mesh, bubbles, colours or obvious branding are not acceptable. Shoes must not have a heel greater than 1.5cm.
- **Appropriate cultural or religious headwear**, such as hijabs, turbans, kippahs, or headscarves, in school colours or in plain, neutral tones.



Term 5-6 Uniform:

- **Shirts** white polo shirts for years 10 and 11 with no ties, pale blue polo shirts for years 7, 8 and 9 with no ties OR button-down smart shirts (short or long sleeved) white for all year groups to be worn with the year group tie.
- Trousers or shorts are permitted, but must be tailored and smart. They must be an

appropriate length. Ankle socks only must be worn (preferably black).

- Bexhill Academy skirts can be worn, but must be worn with black, non-patterned tights.
- **Shoes/Trainers** must be **all black and polishable.** Shoes/Trainers with mesh, bubbles, colours or obvious branding are not acceptable. Shoes must not have a heel greater than 1.5cm. **Shoes/trainers** must have tags **removed.**
- **Appropriate cultural or religious headwear**, such as hijabs, turbans, kippahs, or headscarves, in school colours or in plain, neutral tones.









Jewellery, hair and make-up

- **Jewellery** One single stud earring in each ear lobe, no bracelets, necklaces or rings and no facial piercings other than a small, flat stud nose piercing.
- **Make-up** should preferably not be worn but if it is, it should be very discreet. Students should preferably not wear false eye lashes for school but if they do, they should be small and natural looking. False nails should be natural looking and short in length. Nail varnish can be worn, but no jewels within the nails.
- Only natural looking hair colour is allowed for school. Bright colours are not permitted.
