Dear Parents/Carers

We are writing to you with regards to the Year 7 camping trip on July 10<sup>th</sup> to July 12<sup>th</sup>. Final deadline for payment will 21<sup>st</sup> June and all monies must be received to ensure your child has a place on the trip. There will be a parents meeting for the trip at 6pm in the theatre on the 20<sup>th</sup> June 2019. Below is some important information and kit list.

Coaches will be leaving at 9.30am Wednesday morning and students will need to be at school at normal time not in school uniform. We will return on Friday at approximately 5.00pm.

Students will need to bring with them a packed lunch and drinks as lunch will not be provided for them on Wednesday.

- Ground sheet
- Sleeping mat
- Sleeping Bag
- Pillow
- Blanket

All the above should be wrapped in a parcel using the ground sheet with an elastic bungee holding it together.

- Plastic plate, bowl, cup
- Knife, fork and spoon
- Underwear
- Socks
- T-shirts (not vests)
- Jogging bottoms (for all of the day time activities) Jeans can only be worn in the evening
- Shorts
- Swimsuit
- Jumpers/hoodies
- A waterproof outdoor coat
- Sunhat/ woolly hat (weather appropriate)
- Suncream
- 2 pairs of trainers. - 1 pair of trainers (that can be tied tightly and do not fall off when in muddy water or when high in the air) and 1 pair of clean trainers.
- Two towels (one for swimming – one for shower).
- Toiletries (shower gel, shampoo, deodorant, tooth brush, toothpaste, hair brush)
- Something to sleep in – pyjamas (not nightdress) / t-shirt and jogging bottoms or shorts (It can get cold at night)
- A torch (a head torch is very useful for the night hike)
- An empty / refillable water bottle

- A small bag/rucksack to carry their drinks bottle and suncream around in.
- A black bin liner to put wet/muddy clothing in.
- If students choose to bring any sweets / snacks with them on the trip they must be in a named sealed plastic box so that they do not attract animals.
- No electrical items will be needed as there is nowhere to plug in or charge these items and no responsibility will be held for them.
- All of the above items must be in 1 bag / holdall except the sleeping bag/mat and ground sheet which must be rolled and held together with a bungee cord.
