Summer 2020: Collection of GCSE Results and Centre Assessed Grades

GCSE Results statement

These are the results awarded to you by OFQUAL and can be shared with your college in order to confirm your courses. Please note the results statement belongs to you and we are not permitted to hand it to anyone but you unless we have your prior permission. All uncollected result statements will be posted by 2nd class to the address you've put on your Leavers Form.

Centre Assessed Grades

Additionally, from Wednesday 2nd September, your centre assessed grades will be available to you on request. Please email me if you would like a copy of this. These are the grades the academy sent to the relevant subject exam board. The centre assessed grades are an amalgamation of your classroom assessments, mock exam results and your teacher's professional judgement on the progress you showed in class and in homework. These grades can also be shared with your college if they wish to see them.

Sitting missed GCSE Exams in the Autumn Term

The Government has confirmed its decision to offer you the opportunity to sit any of your missed GCSE exams if you are not happy with the results allocated to you by OFQUAL. This autumn exam series will take place between Monday 2nd and Friday 27th November 2020, a detailed timetable will be confirmed in due course. Full details of how you request to sit any subject exam will be included with your results statement on Thursday 20th August.

Please note: If the Government makes further changes to this rule we will contact you prior to 20th August to confirm any new measures put in place in order to maintain your safety.
